

DO'S & DON'TS - STORAGE & HANDLING

- ✔ Always store the sheets indoors and if kept outdoors, use protective waterproof covers.
 - ✔ Stack material neatly and at least 50cm off the ground to keep all sides and surfaces safe.
 - ✔ Store the material at a slope of 50 degrees to enable rain water to easily drain off.
 - ✔ Inspect the storage space regularly to ensure that it is free of moisture.
 - ✔ If wet, wipe sheets with a clean cloth immediately and separate individually to dry thoroughly.
 - ✔ Use mechanical handling to unload sheets for large projects and manually hand pass individual sheets for medium and small projects.
 - ✔ Always use helmets, hand gloves and shoes while handling material to avoid injury.

- ✘ Do not keep sheets in direct contact with soil.
- ✘ Do not keep sheets vertically or without proper support.
- ✘ Do not slide sheets over rough surfaces or store them on walkways.
- ✘ Do not keep heavy material on top of stacked sheets.
- ✘ Do not use metal chains or bare hands to lift sheets.
- ✘ Do not let the surface of the sheets get wet.
